16	Open Meeting:
17	Chairman Wheeler opened the meeting at 2:45 PM.
18	Public Comment:
19	There were no public comments at this meeting.
20	Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes:
21	The minutes for the October 25th, 2023 were unanimously approved by all. A motion was made
22	by Mayor Schore, followed by a second motion from Mayor Nugent.
23	FY 2024 Unified Work Program Amendments: None at this time.
24	FY 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) - Amendments: None
25	at this time.
26	Travel Time Survey: Rob Fischer presented Travel Time Surveys to the committee from the
27	Spring and Fall of 2022, as well as Spring of 2023. The survey highlights the year-over-year
28	tracking of time driven from one end of major corridors to the other, throughout the county.
29	Highlights included Fall 2022 and Spring 2023 studies from East-West directional roads such as
30	Bourbonnais Parkway, St. George Road, Armour Road, Illinois Route 102, North Street in
31	Bradley, and Larry Power Road.
32	North-South directional roads traveled in Spring of 2022 were US 45/52, Illinois Route 50, as
33	well as County Road 9000N, which is also East-West in direction.

- 34 Individual travel times for each road were discussed, as well as the efficiency of each corridor
- driven during three different times of day: morning, midday, and afternoon. The Fall 2023
- results, containing the previously aforementioned North-South routes, will be presented at the
- 37 next meeting.
- 38 Agency Updates:
- 39 Kankakee County: Mr. Wilson told the committee the there will be a letter of support from the
- 40 MPO going to IDOT, in an effort to capture more funding for the 9000N Road widening project.
- 41 Chairman Wheeler stressed the need to be able to get people in and out of the upcoming
- 42 Gotion battery facility, as the operation is anticipated to bring 2,600 jobs to Manteno, along
- 43 with approximately 150 trucks a day to 9000N Road. Wilson added that the project is currently
- slated to be striped as a 3-lane road, yet constructed as a 5-lane project.
- 45 **IDOT District 3**: Nothing at this time.
- 46 **FHWA:** Nothing at this time.
- 47 **Metro:** Nothing at this time.
- 48 **Safety:** Nothing at this time. A meeting is set for February 7th, 2024.
- 49 **City of Kankakee**: Neil Piggush told the committee that AT&T is still relocating their utilities on
- 50 the North end of Hobbie Avenue and that storm sewer work is ongoing. He also informed the
- committee that improvements on the South portion of Hobbie Avenue are in progress.
- 52 **Kankakee Valley Airport Authority**: Nothing at this time.
- 53 <u>Transportation and Development Division Manager:</u> Ben Wilson told the committee the State
- of Illinois will be setting their Greenhouse Gas standards in February. He added there is a 180-
- day window after the state's announcement for the county to set their own.
- 56 **New Business:**
- 57 A motion was made Mayor Nugent and a second made by Mayor Schore to initiate the process
- of seeking Requests for Proposals (RFP) for the county's Long Range Transportation Plan. Ben
- 59 Wilson told the committee he anticipates receiving responses from interested parties by March
- 60 1st, with the approval of a vendor anticipated on March 27th. The motion passed, unanimously.
