20	Open Meeting:
21	Chairman Heiden opened the meeting at 2:30 PM.
22	Public Comment:
23	There was no public comment at this meeting.
24	Approval of Minutes:
25	Chairman Heiden brought forth the minutes for the January 31st, 2024 meeting. There were no
26	changes. With a unanimous vote, led by a motion from Mr. Larocque and seconded by Mr.
27	Hanley, the motion to approve the minutes carried.
28	FY 2024 Unified Work Program Amendments: None at this time.
29	FY 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) - Amendments:
30	Amendment #3 to the TIP was presented to the Technical Advisory Committee. The
31	amendment featured work on a railroad signal and grade crossing in Kankakee, which was
32	furnished by IDOT. It also contained River Valley Metro's funded items for FY 2024-2027. The
33	motion was made by Mr. Piggush and seconded by Mr. Greer to be moved to the Policy
34	Committee for approval.

- 35 **Metropolitan Planning Area Amendment:** A motion was made by Dr. Gingerich and
- 36 seconded by Mr. LaRocque to move a boundary amendment to the Policy Committee for
- 37 approval. The amendment would add area to the MPA (Metropolitan Planning Area) in the
- 38 Western portion of the current boundaries, as well as include small portions in the Southern,
- Northern, and Eastern portions. The majority of the addition is West of the City of Kankakee
- and East of the Village of Limestone. A map was presented to all members for examination. Ben
- 41 Wilson told the committee that the new additions align with the most recent census blocks.
- 42 IDOT's Tom Caldwell added that "the urbanized area is census-driven".
- 43 **Travel Time Survey Presentation:** Rob Fischer presented a Travel Time Survey to the
- committee from the Fall of 2023. The survey highlights the year-over-year tracking of time
- driven from one end of major corridors to the other, throughout the county. North-South
- directional roads traveled in the Fall of 2023 were US 45/52 and Illinois Route 50. County Road
- 47 9000N and Illinois Route 17 were also studied, which are East-West in direction.
- 48 Individual travel times for each road were discussed, as well as the efficiency of each corridor
- 49 driven during three different times of day: morning, midday, and afternoon. Fischer and Wilson
- 50 discussed efficiency with members of the committee as well.
