18	There were no public comments at this meeting.
19	Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes:
20 21	The minutes for the February 5 <sup>th</sup> 2025 were unanimously approved. A motion was first made by Mayor Curtis, followed by a second motion from Mr. Skimerhorn. All ayes.
22	FY 2025 Unified Work Program Amendments: None at this time.
23 24 25	<b>FY 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) - Amendments:</b> One amendment to the FY 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) has been submitted by IDOT District 3.
26 27 28	The proposed project is traffic signal modernization at two locations on US 45/52. The proposed locations are River Road and South Tec Drive.  The project cost is estimated at \$400,000, with funding from NHPP and IDOT funds.
29 30	A motion was made to approve this amendment by Mayor Curtis and a second was made by Mr. Skimerhorn. All ayes.
31	Approval of Draft FY 2026 Unified Work Program: Ben Wilson discussed with the
32	committee draft UPWP with the committee. Th UPWP is the document that outlines the work
<ul><li>33</li><li>34</li><li>35</li></ul>	program for FY2026. This years work program looks similar to previous years as PL funding is relatively stable. A motion to approve the draft Unified Work Program was made by Mayor Curtis and a second motion came from Mr. Skimerhorn to approve. All ayes.

- 36 **Project Evaluation Results for LRTP:** Mr. Wilson presented the results of the recent LRTP
- 37 project scoring. This year some new elements were included in the scoring criteria after input from
- 38 IDOT D3 and the Kankakee County RPC. Like other years, available funding will not fund but a
- 39 portion of the project list. Mr. Wilson did indicate that the current program projects of 9000 N and
- 40 Career Center Road will utilize funds through FY 2029. When the 2055 LRTP is being drafted the
- 41 next project should be evaluated for funding.
- 42 Agency Updates:
- 43 Kankakee County: Wilson told the committee that the bids for 9000N opened in January and
- 44 that right-of-way and utility costs are higher than expected. He added that he is working on an
- 45 EDP grant to procure the shortage of funding needed to complete the project. The original
- estimate was 9.1 million dollars but projected current cost is closer to 12.3 million.
- 47 **IDOT District 3**: Nothing new at this time.
- 48 **IDOT Urban Planning:** Nothing new at this time.
- 49 **FHWA:** Nothing new at this time.
- 50 Metro: Nothing new at this time.
- 51 **Safety:** Nothing new at this time..
- 52 <u>City of Kankakee</u>: Mayor Curtis added that on Hobbie Avenue, the project will resume once
- weather warms up and concrete and asphalt work can be completed. He expects the project to
- 54 be complete this summer.
- 55 <u>Kankakee Valley Airport Authority</u>: Nothing new at this time.
- 56 <u>Transportation and Development Division Manager:</u> None at this time.
